Joan and Harry Kreutzberg

Joan Griffenberg was born in Riverton, New Jersey and Harry Kreutzberg was born just down the road in Camden, New Jersey. They met in High School in Palmyra, New Jersey and by all reports it was NOT love at first sight. In fact, Joan says she thought that Harry was a bit "conceited" and Harry says he thought Joan was "fickle". By senior year however, they had become friends but Harry was dating Joan. Not Joan Griffenberg but another Joan. At least Harry was on the right track. Speaking of track, Harry was a talented athlete and ran on the track team and also played football. Joan was a cheerleader, performed in musical theatre, and both were involved in student government.

After high school, Harry joined the Marine Corp in 1951 and attended Muhlenberg College on a football scholarship. During college he was drafted by the Pittsburgh Steelers. Joan and Harry married in 1952 and Harry was discharged from the Marines in 1954. Son, Keith, was born in 1955. Harry suffered some injuries playing college football and was now a family man, so he decided on a path other than athletics. Joan worked at Muhlenberg College in the Education Department and Harry graduated in 1956.

Harry immediately started working for the DuPont Corporation, learning everything he could about the textile industry. The family kept on growing and soon included Kirk, Kyle, Kim and Kipp. He was a fast learner and soon his company trusted him now to oversee operations abroad and the Kreutzberg family moved to the North of England, London and Geneva, Switzerland.

The family returned to the United States in 1978, first to New York City, then Princeton Junction, New Jersey and finally Wilmington, Delaware. In the 1980's, Harry retired from DuPont with a golden parachute, and then worked for Hanson Trust for six years. Harry and Joan decided to move to a condo in Bradenton, FL in 1981, exploring what it would be like to live in Florida. They decided Florida was a good fit and purchased a home in Highland Lakes, next door to St. Mark Village. Joan and Harry were very active in the Highland Lakes community. They both performed in little theatre, sang, Joan with the Highland Lassies, and Harry in a barbershop quartet.

Harry's mother, Mary Lee, moved to St. Mark Village in 1991 and lived here ten years, so the Kreutzberg's got to know The Village very well and in 2006 moved in. They continued to use their musical talent to entertain the Residents. Always generous with their time, they sang in the St. Mark Village choir, volunteered at large open houses, participated in photo shoots, and could be counted on to assist the Residents and staff at St. Mark, whenever they were asked. Harry is also a talented painter and has recently shown his work in our annual art show.

Recently, both have spent short stints in Betty Fresh Rehab & Spa. As they recovered they told me how wonderful it was to come back HOME for rehab, where they know and trust the staff, can easily visit each other, and receive support and encouragement from many friends, who just have to walk through the hallways of The Village to check on them. Both Joan and Harry describe their years at St. Mark as "outstanding and thrilling". "There are so many things to do, our family loves visiting us here, and we have made some very, very, special friends." I think we can all see why.


LIVING LARGE AT ST. MARK VILLAGE
