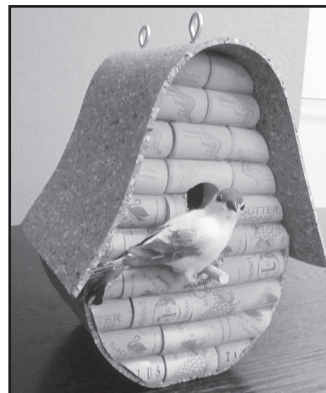
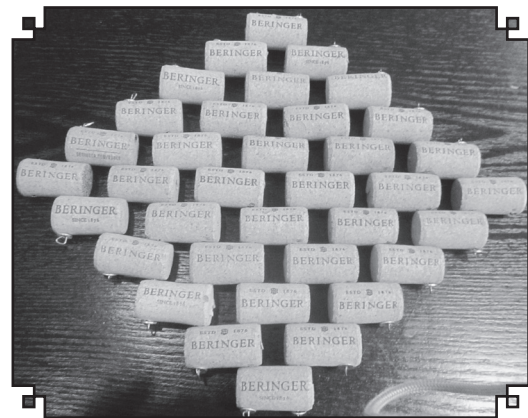
From the Activities Department

Featured Resident of the Month:

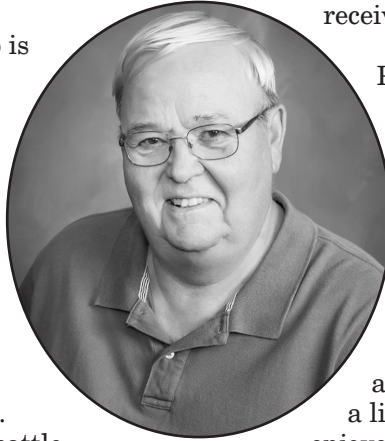
Robert Lee Richter

Our Resident of the Month featured in September 2017 is Robert Lee Richter. Bob is from the Paullina area where his wife Rita still lives on their family's farm.

He was born May 29, 1942 in Primghar, Iowa. His parents were Walter and Nellie (Jurgensen) Richter. Bob was the youngest of three children with an older sister, Alice May Carnahan from Worthington, MN and also an older brother Leslie Richter of Sanborn, Iowa.

He grew up on a farm northwest of Paullina, where he continued to farm into his adult years starting on his own in 1974. While Bob farmed he also at one time had cattle, feeder pigs, milking cows, and chickens for eggs. He retired from farming in 2013 and decided to rent the farm ground.

Bob attended the Paullina Public Schools and the Zion Lutheran School in Paullina graduating from Paullina High School in 1961. He says his favorite childhood memory is of his 7th birthday when he



received a maroon Montgomery Ward bicycle.

Bob met his wife Rita (Duncanson), from Pierson, Iowa, while they attended the same school. They were in choir together and Bob would visit Rita while she worked as a soda jerk at Lange's Café in Paullina. Their first date was attending Bob's senior prom. Slow Cooker Cinnamon Roll Breakfast Casserole

Ingredients:

- (2) 12-ounce Cinnamon Roll Tubes
- (4) Eggs
- ½ Cup Heavy Whipping Cream
- (3) TBSP Maple Syrup
- (2) TSP Vanilla Extract
- (1) TSP Ground Cinnamon
- ¼ TSP Ground Nutmeg

Spray your slow cooker bowl with a non-stick cooking spray.

Place one roll of quartered cinnamon roll pieces at the bottom of your slow cooker. (Save the frosting packets for later.)

In a small bowl, beat (4) eggs.

To the beaten eggs, add the heavy whipping cream, maple syrup, vanilla extract, cinnamon & nutmeg. (Blend well.)

Pour the egg mixture evenly over the cinnamon rolls in the slow cooker.

Place remaining roll of quartered cinnamon rolls on top of the mixture in the slow cooker.

Cover and cook on low for 2.5 hours, or until sides are golden brown and the rolls are set.

Spread frosting that came in the cinnamon roll tubes over the warm cinnamon roll casserole.

Serve warm.

Slow-Cooker Chocolate Lava Cake

Ingredients

Cake

- 1 box Betty Crocker™ SuperMoist™ triple chocolate fudge cake mix
- 1 1/4 cups milk • 1/2 cup vegetable oil • 3 eggs

Topping

- 1 box (4-serving size) instant chocolate pudding and pie filling mix
- 2 cups milk
- 1 bag (12 oz) milk chocolate chips (2 cups)

Steps

Spray 6-quart slow cooker with cooking spray. In large bowl, beat cake ingredients with electric mixer as directed on cake mix box. Pour into slow cooker.

In medium bowl, beat pudding mix and 2 cups milk with whisk as directed on box. Pour into slow cooker over cake batter. Do not mix. Sprinkle chocolate chips over top.


Cover; cook on low heat setting 2 hours 30 minutes to 3 hours or until cake is set and pudding is beginning to bubble out of cake.
