In addition to the Great Haunted Room in the Nursing Facility, Assisted Living staff and tenants had a Haunted House pictured above! Right, Bev Halling wore



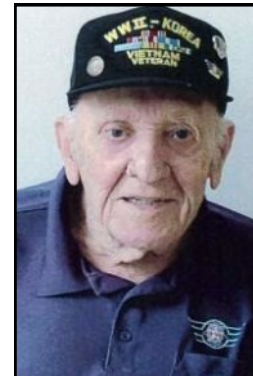
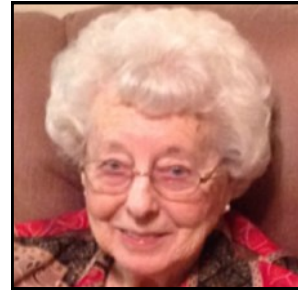
