Rowley Masonic Community completed a recent contract agreement with Dr. Robert Conner to be official Medical Director for the facility beginning September 1, 2018. Dr. Conner, certified Gerontologist, will oversee all treatments and cares for all residents as Medical Director, and residents have, of course, their preference of primary care physician honored. Residents can change primary care physician as they wish. If any resident would like to see Dr. Conner while here at Rowley, please notify your charge nurse to make your wishes known. He will be assisted by Jacquelyn Williams, ARNP in overseeing the care at Rowley.

New Medicare Cards

Your Medicare card number is changing as a result of Congressional legislation passed in 2015 requiring CMS to remove all participants' Social Security Numbers (SSN). This is to help prevent Medicare fraud and financial identity theft by not making this information readily available on Medicare cards that could be lost or stolen.

Basically, your current SSN-based Health Insurance Claim Number (HICN) will be replaced by a new Medicare Beneficiary Identifier (MBI). Your MBI will be used for Medicare transactions such as billing, eligibility status, and claim status.

New Medicare cards 2018 will be mailed out on a staggered scheduled in seven waves based on geographical regions. Iowa cards were scheduled to be mailed out the last week in June through the end of July. Be sure to check your mail, or check with your responsible party to ensure your cards have safely arrived.

We appreciate your help in getting copies of your new Medicare cards to the Rowley Masonic Community office for inclusion in your resident profile. This allows us to efficiently and accurately submit claims to Medicare on your behalf should that need arise.

Any time your insurance information changes, please be sure to notify the Business Administration Office and make sure we have copies on file for you.

No matter what, your Medicare card numbers should never be given out over the phone, but only in person to healthcare or medical provider entities.
