

Meet the neighbors Pat Davies



When we talk about engaged living at Ingleside at Rock Creek, we're talking about people like Pat Davies. A Brit with a background in organizing large, international conferences, she is an enthusiastic volunteer despite living with Parkinson's disease.

Pat came to the United States in 1991 from her home in the United Kingdom to take a job with the World Bank, organizing its annual and Spring meetings until her retirement in 2007. Two years later she was diagnosed with Parkinson's and did extensive research to learn as much as she could about the disease. She searched for information about living alone with Parkinson's but found nothing.

"I realized I had to be my own caregiver and my own advocate," she says. "I decided I needed to do as much as I could for as long as I could." Pat became a research advocate and participated in clinical trials. She was appointed to the steering committee of the World Parkinson Congress and joined the faculty of the organization in 2016, co-

chairing sessions in Portland, Oregon, on clinical trials and presenting a round table on single people living with Parkinson's.




Davies is a 2016 recipient of the prestigious *Washingtonian of the Year Award*. She also chairs the buildings and grounds committee at Georgetown Presbyterian Church, and represents the church on the Board of the Georgetown Ministry Center, a day center for the homeless. She was president of that organization in 2015-16, helping to organize floating shelters at various churches and rounding up volunteers to provide dinner for the homeless. She has also served as chair of Children of Uganda, an organization that works with orphans and vulnerable children. Through that agency, she sponsors a boy with cerebral palsy and a goddaughter in Uganda, whom she considers her children. She also has a dog, Patrick, whom she adopted to help motivate her to exercise.

"He hates to walk," she says with a laugh. "I have to drive him home now."

Pat exemplifies the spirit of Ingleside at Rock Creek. Although she currently lives in a home she loves, she is very much looking forward to her new home and neighbors when Creekside addition opens.

"I wanted to find a place where I would very quickly feel at home and meet like-minded souls," she says. "I looked at a lot of places, and I always came back to this one. There are a lot of people who have traveled and worked in other countries."

The assurance that her needs would be taken care of allows Pat to maintain her active, giving lifestyle. "I hope I'm going to be able to continue to do many of the things I already do," she says. "I would like to be part of finding better treatments, or even a cure, for Parkinson's."


