The Tuscaloosa Barnyard – September 13th

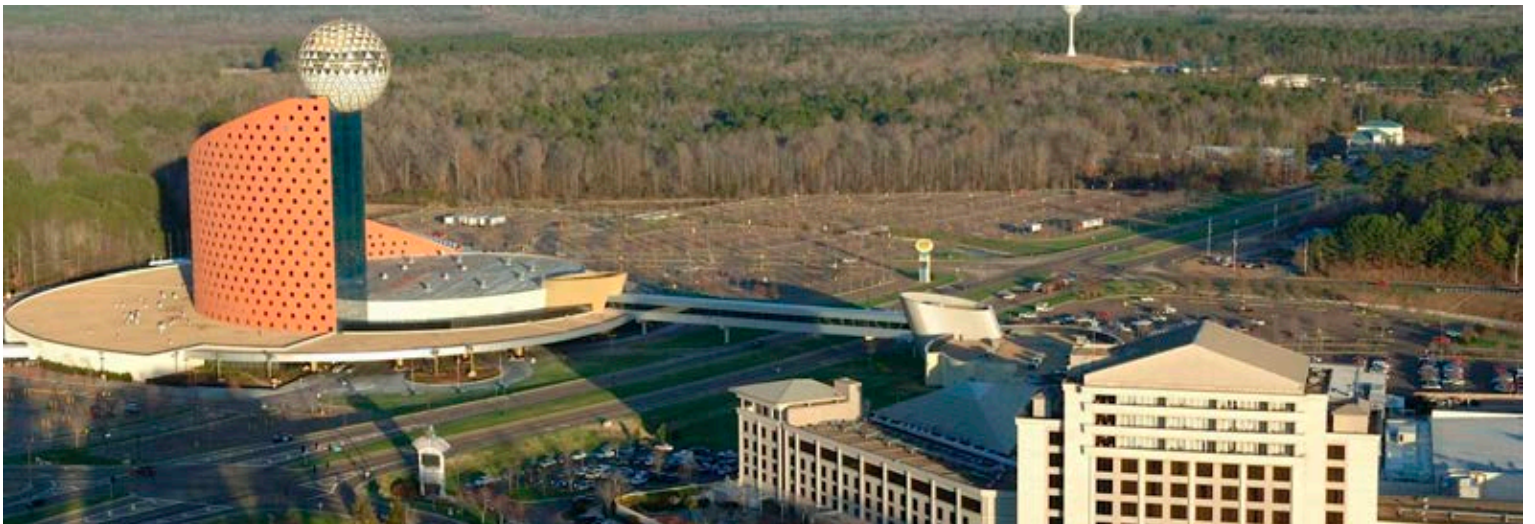

Janace Benson

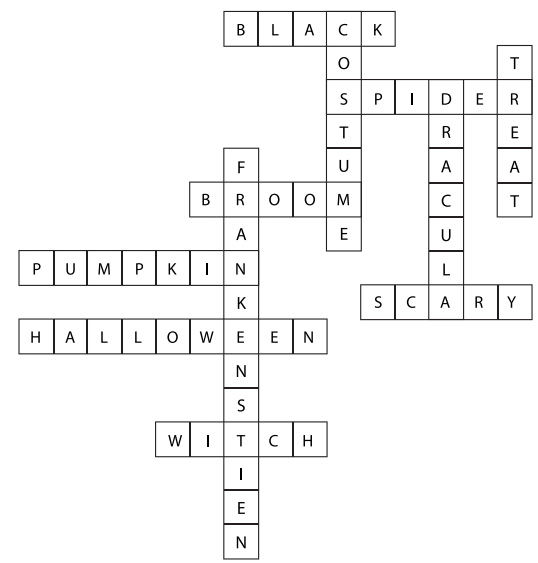


Janace is a hard-working, dedicated, and compassionate caregiver. She's always willing to go the extra mile whenever needed and gives great care to the residents.
