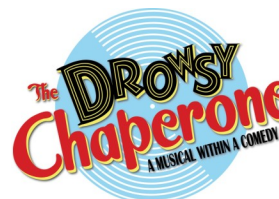
Odd Fellows and Rebekahs Jewel Presentation
