New programs are in store for all of your enjoyment in the New Year and we are so thankful for the addition of Ria Ruane, our new Spiritual Director.

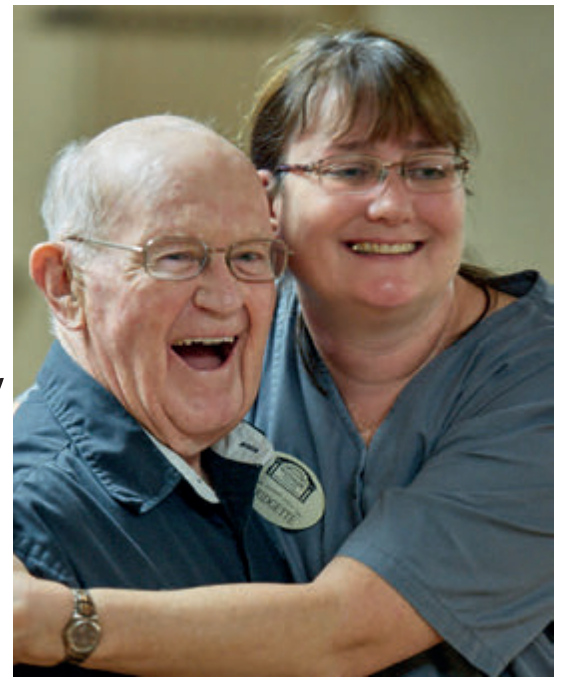
