Stonehill Organizational Updates...

Area Residential Care (ARC) and Stonehill Franciscan Services have shared a long partnership over the years. However, due to changes in federal dollars, difficulty in recruiting ARC employees and the development of our Service Techs, a mutual decision was to end our contract June 30, 2017. ARC employees will have the opportunity to apply for employment with Stonehill. ARC is working hard to find alternative work sites for those who need the additional support of a job coach and together our goal is to ensure a nice transition for our ARC employees. We thank ARC and their employees for the support and joy they brought to our campus!

Some time ago, I heard Dr. Sanjay Gupta speak and he said the 2 things older people wish they would have taken better care of is their teeth and their feet. I find this to be true as I get older too!! Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) also support proper oral hygiene and has written new regulation requiring oral health assessments. Stonehill is fortunate to work with Crescent Community Health and Dr. Chris Strohmeyer. Both providers come to Stonehill which supports easy access and treatment. For any questions regarding these services, please feel free to ask our social workers, Michelle Booher, Kristin Beusse or Sheila Van Gordon.

A "Farewell Blessing" is something we offer at the time of a resident's passing. This involves asking permission from the resident's family or representative to announce the passing and a final blessing will take place at the main entrance. We will ring a bell prior to announcing so members of Stonehill will know we have lost one of our own. If permission is granted the name of the resident will be said and anyone available can participate for the final blessing at the main entrance. Reverence is part of our core values and we recognize in life and in death, we all share in God's divine mercy.

We recently hired Susi DuBois as our Dining Services Director. Susi is working closely with her team and some wonderful changes are happening in the delivery of dining services. One area of study is the presentation of food. One such change involved our Compassionate Cart. This is a cart filled with nourishment and refreshments to help sustain family and/or friends when their loved one is making their final journey home. We have had many compliments since this change and if you have any thoughts or ideas on how to improve our delivery of dining services, we would be happy to hear from you!

It doesn't matter how big or small the act, what matters is that we let them know how much it meant to you.



### Going To The Chapel by Fran Mancl, CNA – Pastoral Care Team Member
