PVH News – January 2018 Chaplain's Article

We have come to that "season" of year when many people make New Years Resolutions; and to make one or more of them, I believe, is a good thing. It suggests that the individual is seeking to do better, that he is not satisfied with *status quo*.

Today, I received a note from a missionary acquaintance who has ministered in South Africa since 1989; matter of fact, he was born and reared in South Africa; but somehow in the providence of God, he became part of a mission organization with headquarters here in America. He passed along the following thought-provoking lines: 1) "Action without vision is just passing time;" 2) "Vision without action is just day-dreaming;" and 3) "Vision with action can change the world." This same missionary considered his life and ministry over the previous 28 years, and seriously pondered what he had accomplished, but more importantly, what he was accomplishing today, and where he seemed to be headed for the year ahead.

This is sound thinking. Let's put this into the simplest terms possible: 1) What have I accomplished in the previous five or ten years? Name at least one accomplishment that you did that honored the Lord Jesus Christ. 2) What would you like to see accomplished through your life in this year to come? Can you think of any personal involvement that the Savior could bless, and that honor Him?

Writing to a group of believers in Philippi, the apostle Paul, a prisoner in Rome, expressed a thought that revealed his dissatisfaction with *status quo*, and that he wanted to do more for his Lord. Here it is in Phillips Paraphrase (Philippians 3:12), "My brothers, I do not consider myself to have arrived spiritually; nor do I consider myself already perfect; but I keep going on, grasping ever more firmly that purpose for which Christ Jesus grasped me." Should we be surprised that some from Caesar's household trusted in Christ? Paul was a witness for his Lord; may we all follow in his tracks! 

Bill of Rights of Pleasant View Home

Know Your Rights under Federal Nursing Home Regulations

1. What are your Federal rights in a nursing home?

As a resident of Pleasant View Home, you have certain rights and protections under Federal law that help ensure you get the care and services you need.

Pleasant View Home must provide you with a written description of your legal rights. Keep the information you receive about your rights, admission and transfer policies, and any other information from Pleasant View Home in case you and/or your representative need to look at them later.

2. Generally

All residents have the right to equal access to quality care regardless of diagnosis, severity of condition, or payment source.

3. Exercise of Rights

You have the right to exercise your rights as a resident of Pleasant View Home and as a citizen of the United States, without fear of interference, coercion, discrimination or reprisal. You and/or your representative have the right to organize or participate in resident and/or family groups. You also have the right to choose a representative, including a spouse (opposite or same sex), family member, friend or others to exercise your rights on your behalf. Legal guardians appointed on your behalf may exercise your rights according to state law. You retain the ability to exercise any rights that you do not delegate to a representative.

4. Planning and Implementing Care

You and/or your representative have the right to be fully informed of your medical condition in a language you can understand, and to participate in your person-centered care planning and treatment, including the type of caregiver who provides services to you. You also have the right to refuse and/or discontinue medications and treatments (but this could be harmful to your health), and to formulate an






