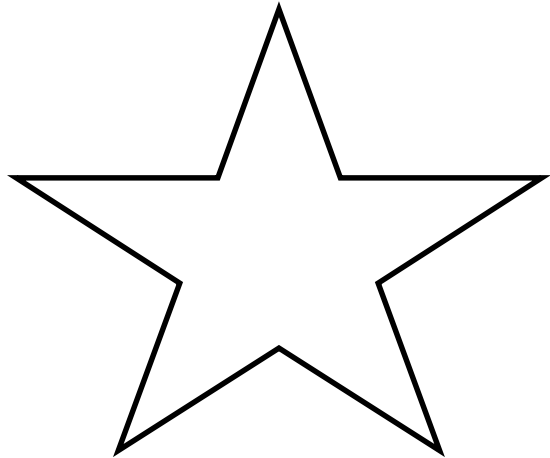

PVH News – Chaplain’s Article

Romans 8:35, 37 NLT

Does it mean He no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity....No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

The recently completed Winter Olympics of Pyeongchang, South Korea, were not a “smashing success” for the US Olympic team; yet, there were notable victories, meaning Gold Medal winners, people like Shaun White, in the Halfpipe event, the Women’s Gold medal-winning Hockey Team, and Mchaela Shriffrin, winner of the slalom ski event; but one Gold medal winning team was a great shock to many Olympic followers. It was the five-member US Men’s team winning the curling event, an event so strange to many of us, that it appears that it requires only two skills: deftly scooting a 38-pound stone along some ice, and a couple broom sweepers helping guide the movement of that stone. Expressed more simply: it doesn’t appear to the uninitiated viewer to require much skill. But don’t mention that to the curlers!

What impressed me about the men’s team of five is that they looked very much like the ordinary man on the street, or that man you may see in your local church. They were VERY ORDINARY-LOOKING! Just like you and me; but THEY WERE CHAMPIONS! Carrying that thought to the biblical text above, the apostle Paul reminds us there (and in several places of his writings) that every believer in Christ, who keeps his eyes on his Lord and Savior, following in His steps, is also a champion. One day every faithful man and woman will receive a medal; it’s called a Crown.

## Bed Rail Safety

Between hospitals and nursing homes there have been 803 incidents of patients caught, trapped, entangled, or strangled between 1983 and 2009, according to the US Food and Drug Administration. Of these, 480 died.

Elders who are frail or confused are especially vulnerable.

Most residents can be in bed safely without bedrails. Concerns for falling from the bed may be addressed in other ways.














Pleasant View takes resident safety seriously and is evaluating the safety and needs for rails or assist devices on beds. The care planning team, nurses, and the therapy providers will assess residents as to whether bed rails are indicated for residents who have bed rails or other bed assistive devices. There may be a period of adjustment as bed rails and assist bars are removed, based on these evaluations.

Where bed rails or assist bars appear to be necessary, for a specific circumstance, and other options are not available, the responsible party will be asked to sign a risk/benefit statement to identify their understanding that bed rails may lead to negative consequences, including death.

Even when bed rails are properly designed, there is risk for the resident, and other elements including the mattress condition, condition of the resident, sleep habits, medications, physical ability, mobility and other factors play a role in bed safety.

Pleasant View has a great reputation for quality care, and we continue to ensure our residents will be as safe as possible by limiting the use of bed rails and assist

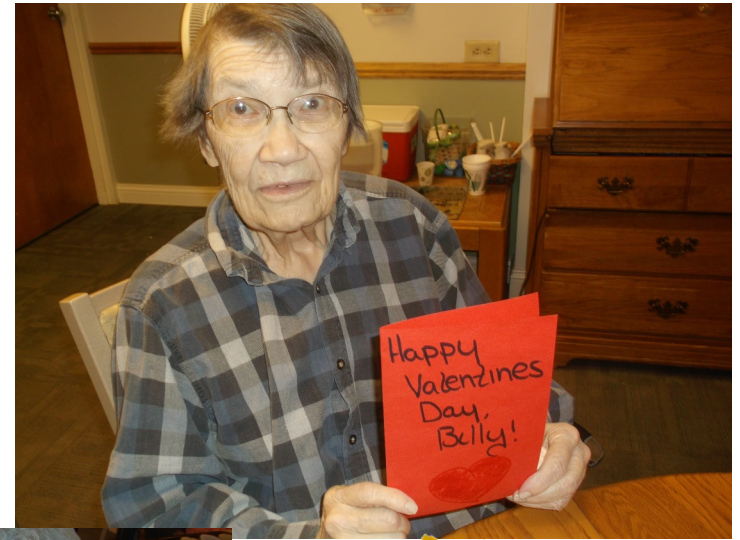
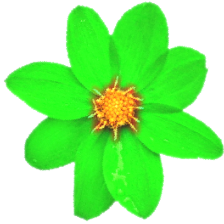
