Historic Letter Collection

Bill and Julie Penick, Lambeth House residents, started collecting original handwritten historic letters around 1990. Today, this impressive collection of 43 letters is on display at Lambeth House along the walls between the Main Lobby and Martin's Landing. What began initially as an interest in black and white photography and history segued into a journey of incredible letter collecting.



"It all started by thumbing through catalogs that had historical documents for sale. The first letter we purchased was written by Napoleon," said Bill Penick. After the first letter was purchased, their name began to appear on other mailing lists for catalogs and at auction houses. Penick states, "We became hooked and the letter collection began to grow." The collection was never intended to be an investment, strictly to satisfy historical interest.

The collection includes original letters from national military leaders, writers, philosophers, revolutionaries, and scientists. Names such as Queen Elizabeth, Sir Isaac Newton, Abraham Lincoln, Sun Yat-Sen, Louis Pasteur and Tolstoy make up this notable and extraordinary collection.

The Penicks were quite fascinated with who signed the letter, the recipient of the particular letter, the content and the date of the letter. Although Mr. Penick says he doesn't have a favorite, there are a few that stand out to him -- the handwritten Bible pages, Horatio Nelson, and the Cuneiform which dates back to 2000 B.C.

Lambeth House is extremely proud to house this historic letter collection and grateful to the Penicks for allowing such a display to adorn the halls. If you have not yet spent time reading these letters, we invite you to do so. It's a history lesson you won't soon forget.
