#### A New Year!

New surveillance equipment was installed at the entrances and electronic documentation applications for medication administration and personal care services were implemented.

We are looking forward to starting eMenu live on January 2<sup>nd</sup>. With eMenu the tenants will have more food choices and they will have the ability to specify their dining requests a week in advance. Dining services will be streamlined with no need for our servers to take food orders at the table, alleviating long wait times for meals to be served and more efficient service at meals. A kiosk with an electronic tablet has been added at the dining room entrance for tenants to log into eMenu and make their menu choices for each week. Donna Steiner, Food Service Manager, and Lisa Ceplecha, Office Support, are steering our efforts to educate tenants on this new dining service. Donna and Lisa will assist tenants with their weekly food selections if they are unable to do so or need assistance.

In addition to eMenu, 2019 will also bring the implementation of a new, updated nurse call/communication system and digital displays in the lobby and main dining room areas for daily communication to tenants and guests. The new technologies will offer opportunities for creating staff efficiencies and improved service to our tenants.

Remember the influenza season is upon us! We have been fortunate so far with no reported flu or flu-like illnesses for our tenants, but we are still in the middle of the flu season. As a reminder, all guests are asked to please reconsider visiting if they are not feeling well. Handwashing and avoiding contact with tenants until symptom free are the best ways to stop the spread of germs. Please make regular use of the available hand sanitizer stations at each entrance when you enter and before you leave the building.
