### Culinary Offerings

The community has been partnering with acclaimed **Morrison Senior Living** since 1999 to deliver high-quality dining services and top-notch culinary offerings to residents.

Attention to proper nutrition is always at the foundation of the community's culinary

offerings. Menus and cuisine are developed in collaboration with a staff of certified dietitians, and include a selection of "heart-healthy" offerings.

Through the *Garden to Table* initiative, residents enjoy freshly picked, local foods grown and gathered by residents, staff, cooks and chefs from the community.

*Flavors 450* – a nationally recognized program developed by celebrity chef Cary Neff – is offered from the Chef's Center Stage Kitchen weekly.
