Latest Scams to Look Out For:

- "There is a lawsuit filed against you by the Internal Revenue Service, and there is an on-bailable arrest warrant issued under your name. Before we move forward with a lawsuit, please contact us as soon as possible at 84-312-7487. I repeat...."
- A call to demand immediate payment using specific payment method such as a prepaid debit card, gift card or wire transfer. Generally, the IRS will first mail you a bill if you owe any taxes.
- Threaten to bring in local police or other law-enforcement groups to have you arrested for not paying.
- Demand payment without giving you the opportunity to question or appeal the amount they say you owe.
- Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone.
- Grandkids calling saying they need to be bailed out of jail scam.
- Computer Virus Scam & Computer Servicing Scams.


The carnation comes in several different colors to convey different meanings much like roses. A pink carnation means affection, while a red carnation means "I love you".


