Connecting with Dementia - Surprising Facts about Alzheimer's Disease Amanda McDuffie, LPN Al Unit Manager

• With an estimated five

million Americans who have Alzheimer's, the cost for treating the disease continues to rise. In 2016 that figure reached about \$235 billion. The number of Americans with the disease is expected to increase in the years ahead. It is estimated that Alzheimer's may cost the U.S. more than \$1 trillion by 2050. A German doctor names Alois Alzheimer first observed the disease in 1906. He described a patient knows as Auguste D. who had memory loss and other problems thinking. After the patients's death, Dr. Alzheimer noted that parts of the patient's brain were shrunken. A psychiatrist who worked with Dr. Alzheimer names the

condition in 1910.

The time it takes for Alzheimer's to progress varies from person to person, so it's hard to predict how long someone with the condition will live. Younger adults who are diagnosed with the disease tend to live longer than those diagnosed later in life.
