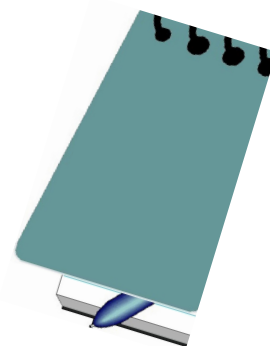

They are working six days a week to keep on schedule for The Vista's completion next fall. Last month, I shared information about the ground floor and underground parking level. This month, we are moving to the first floor which is the main entry level.

When driving in the campus now, you can get a better sense of The Vista's main entrance. Often the protective fencing there is open which allows a better perspective of the visitor's experience when they arrive to our new building. Our new lobby will be much larger than the current lobby in Lawther Point East and there will be a very clearly defined reception area as our families and guests arrive. 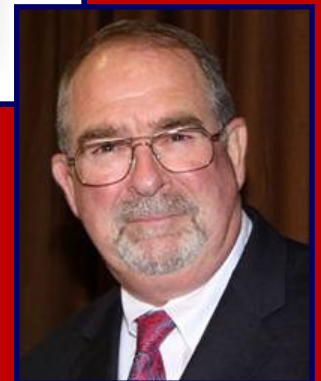

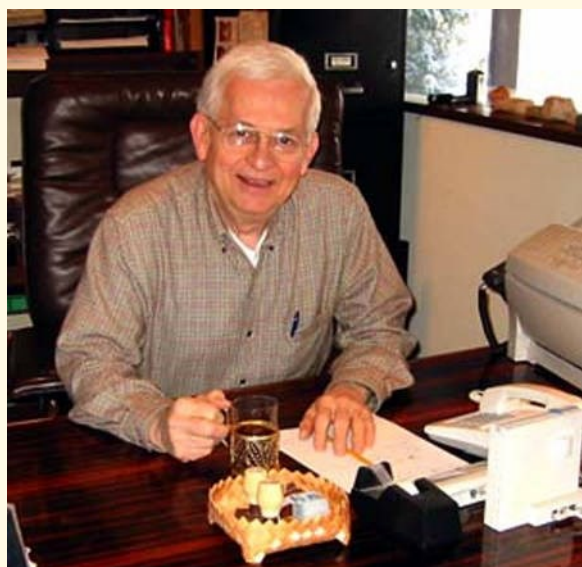
