Honoring the 75th Anniversary of Pearl Harbor



On December 7th, 1941, Japanese planes attacked the US Navy base at Pearl Harbor on the Hawaiian Island of Oahu. In 2016, on the 75th anniversary of the attacks, many American schoolchildren will hear for the first time the famous line from President Franklin Roosevelt: "a date which will live in infamy." Though those students may not understand it, the tragedy at Pearl Harbor is all too alive in the hearts of the Americans who lost loved ones that day. Thousands are expected to gather at the memorial early that Wednesday morning, and a live-stream of the commemoration will be

available online through the National Parks Department.

Below are a few tried and true tips to keep the cravings in check:


- -Don't skip meals to compensate for over-treating yourself! Balanced meals will help prevent more indulgences.
