
Brownsburg Meadows earns another deficiency-free score

Brownsburg Meadows Assisted Living was again found to have no deficiencies during an inspection by the Indiana State Board of Health (ISDH).

The ISDH inspects licensed facilities to assess compliance with state standards of care, such as adequacy of staffing, quality of care and cleanliness of facilities.

A deficiency-free score is the best score an assisted living community can receive and is a distinction achieved by a low percentage of such communities statewide. Last year's inspection also showed the community had no deficiencies.
