Our Foundation, which was established to help VSB in accomplishing its mission, consists of several different funds, allowing our contributors to designate the fund of their choice when donating to the Foundation.

Expenses are kept to a minimum, with management and administrative salaries paid by Villa St. Benedict, and not from the Foundation.

Charitable Care Fund

VSB continues to distinguish itself with its Charity Care program. It is our commitment that our residents will always have a home at Villa St. Benedict, regardless of financial difficulties. VSB applied over \$300,000 last year so these residents can stay in their VSB homes.

The Foundation is proud to help offset those costs through the generosity of our contributors to the Foundation. With your help, we look forward to increasing that fund dramatically this coming year.

Employee Participation Fund

Our employees have established this Foundation fund directly through payroll deductions, and indirectly through the hard work and contribution at our employee sponsored events.

Last year we saw a big increase in the direct employee contributions with many donating a PTO (Vacation and other time off earned) to the Foundation.

Tribute Bench and Tree Programs

Our Tribute benches and trees are a great way to honor a loved one, and this year we held a "special" on our Tribute Bench program.

As a result, we now have expanded the outdoor seating for our residents with the addition of five new Tribute Benches on campus. The location for the benches is chosen by the contributor from a map marking the available bench locations throughout campus.

The wording for the laser inscription for each bench is also determined by the contributor. Two slats

of the bench can be engraved, honoring a loved one while providing residents with beautiful outdoor seating for years to come.

The benches are designed to last a long time, with a 10 year guarantee from the manufacturer, and they complement our campus!

Our Tribute Trees are planted on our grounds in one of the locations determined by our groundskeeper as suitable for the particular tree. A plaque accompanies each tree with an inscription in the words of the contributor.

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
