

Apparently, this resident had always been fearful about money throughout her life. Shortly after she moved here, I had learned about her fears and so I met with her, explaining our commitment to our residents. I finished simply, "God brought you to a perfect place. You need not fear being forced to move from your Villa St. Benedict home for financial reasons." The daughter remembered the phone call she received from her mother after that conversation, and the relief and comfort it brought. As the years passed, the resident did eventually apply for our Charitable Care Program. After learning that she was accepted for the program, the daughter received another phone call – this time with gratitude that we had kept our promise.

It is always comforting to be reminded of the impact that our commitment has for our residents and their families. This program is just one of the ways the Foundation helps us achieve our mission. Always know that your contributions make a difference.
